

EARTIPPING



Eartipping is the removal of the distal one-quarter of your cat's ear. See the photo above as an example of a cat that has been eartipped. Eartipping is irreversible.

Eartipping identifies that a cat is part of a managed feral colony. Friendly stray cats and pet cats should not be eartipped.

If your cat is allowed outdoors, it should wear a safety collar with an identification tag and be microchipped. This will increase the chances of your cat being returned to you if it goes missing.
